The Macksburg City Council met on November 2, 2020 7:00 p.m. at the City Hall located in Macksburg, Iowa.

Mayor Jackson called the meeting to order. Roll call was taken. City Council members present, McKinney, Webb, Spencer, Hensley. City Council Member Davis absent. No citizens present.

Hensley made a motion to approve the agenda; McKinney seconded, and all carried with ayes.

City Council Board Communication:

City Council reviewed possible grants that SICOG is offering and City Clerk Gardner and City Council Spencer will be contacting SICOG about possible grants. Grants include a playground grant, a recycling grant and a street sign grant.

City Council asked City Clerk for updated City Ordinance books.

Old Business:

City Council discussed the Street Signs. City Clerk to order more street signs and parts for street signs so that the street sign project can be completed. City Clerk Gardner to contact Iowa Prison Industries to order more signs and parts.

City Council Member McKinney made a motion for City Clerk to order new computer, new printer and cell phone for the city; Seconded my City Council Member Hensley and all carried with ayes.

City Council received a letter from Becky Faust giving an update of the CEM building and all of the remodeling and updating that has been done to the CEM building. CEM advised there would be a open out at the CEM in the future but no date yet.

City Council reviewed two possible contracts with the Waste Management for Recycling Bin. One was for a 30 yard recycling Bin that would cost \$75.00 a month and \$302.22 per pick up. The second contract was for a 20 yard recycling bin and it would cost \$75.00 a month and \$200.00 per pick up. Council asked City Clerk to contact waste management to find out why there is a \$75.00 a month charge, contact SICOG about a possible grant, put a sign up by the recycling bin about making donations and also adding a Facebook poll and post about the recycling bin. City Council also ready a citizen input letter from a citizen asking to please consider keeping the recycling bin.

NOTE: If you use the recycling bin was ask that if possible, to make a donation to help with the cost of the recycling bin. The donations can be left inside the foyer of City Hall in a small black locked box.

New Business:

City Council Reviewed the two bids that were received for Snow Removal. City Council Member Spencer made a motion to accept Drew Witt Snow Removal to removed snow for the winter of 2020-2021; Seconded by City Council Member Webb and all carried with ayes.

Mayor Jackson and City Council Member Webb discussed golf cart.

Council McKinney made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:26 pm; Seconded by Spencer and all carried with ayes. The next City Council meeting will be on December 7th, 2020 at 7pm at Macksburg City Hall. All Public is welcome to attend.
