The Macksburg City Council met on December 7, 2020 7:00 p.m. at the City Hall located in Macksburg, Iowa.

Mayor Jackson called the meeting to order. Roll call was taken. City Council members present, McKinney, Webb, Spencer, Davis. City Council Member Hensley absent. Becky Faust citizens present.

McKinney made a motion to approve the agenda; Davis seconded, and all carried with ayes.

Davis made a motion to approve the consent agenda which included minutes from November 2nd, 2020 City Council Regular Meeting, November 2020 City Treasure Report, and December 2020 bills to be paid; Webb seconded, and all carried with ayes.

Public Forum:

City Council Board Communication:

Old Business:

City Council discussed the Street Signs. The street signs are about 75% done.

City Clerk advised computer, phone and printer have been ordered and have been shipped.

City Council reviewed possible contracts with the Waste Management for Recycling Bin. One was for a 20 yard open topped recycling Bin that would cost \$200.00 a month and be put on a scheduled monthly pick up, this contract would also be a locked in three-year contract. City Council discussed the pros and cons of the recycling bin. And due the high cost of the council has decided to abandon the recycling bin for the time being. City Clerk Spencer made a motion to have abandon the recycling bin for the time being seconded by McKinney and all carried with ayes.

City Clerk advised that the City CD's have been renewed at .3% for 395 days.

New Business:

Nuisance Complaints – None Received

City Council Member McKinney made a motion to approve the AFR; seconded by Webb and all carried with ayes.

City Council Member Davis made a motion to purchase two fire extinguishers for City Hall. One that will be put in the foyer of City Hall and one that will be put inside of City Hall. Seconded by McKinney and all carried with ayes.

City Council talked about possible grants and updates of grants that SICOG is offering. At this time there are no grants that the City will be applying for.

City Council Member Davis made a motion to pay all missing payments that City Clerk Gardner had found that needed to be paid: United States Treasury tax period 2018 \$46.23, Waste Management Past Due \$1042.64, United States Treasury Tax period ending 2017 \$100.19, SICOG Annual Payment past due \$122.61; seconded by McKinney and all carried with ayes.

City Council Spoke about That Place Subdivision less than two miles east of Macksburg. City of Macksburg received a resolution about subdivision and Council asked Clerk Gardner to call and get information on what they would be building in that subdivision. City Clerk Gardner called and spoke to Mark Smith with Jordan, Oliver and Smith and he advised they were just splitting a property to build a second house on, and it would be residential. Resolution was signed.

Council McKinney made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:37 pm; Seconded by Webb and all carried with ayes. The next City Council meeting will be on January 4, 2021 at 7pm at Macksburg City Hall. All Public is welcomed to attend.
